


DAY 2: LIMA / DISCOVERY OF LIMA'S HISTORIC CENTER - CUSCO (11150FT) (Date to be determined)

Breakfast.

Meeting with our English-speaking tour guide.

9:00 AM: Exploration of Lima's historic center. Transfer to downtown. We will see the famous San Martin Square, a vast square located in the center of Lima and surrounded by important

monuments and buildings. In the center of the square stands an imposing shrine in memory of José de San Martin, liberator of Peru. Next, we will proceed to the **Plaza Mayor** via Union Street, where Spanish conquistador **Francisco Pizarro** founded the city of Lima in 1535, naming it the City of Kings. In this area, we will admire the architecture of that era, appreciate the beautiful balconies, and colonial-style mansions. Around Plaza Mayor, we can see **the Government Palace**, **Lima City Hall, the Cathedral, and the Archbishop's Palace**.

Visit to **the Convent of San Francisco**, a remarkable architectural masterpiece constructed in the 17th century. Entrance to the catacombs.

Transfer to Lima International Airport and check-in for a flight to the Sacred City of Cusco.

DAY 3: CUSCO / 4 RUINS & DISCOVERY OF THE HISTORICAL CENTER (Date to be determined)

Breakfast.

Meeting with our English-speaking tour guide.

9:00 AM: **Discovery of the 4 ruins**. Departure by private transport to the heights of Cusco to visit *the 4 ruins*. Our first stop will be at the site of **Tambomachay**. Nicknamed the "Bath of the Inca", Tambomachay has two fountains always functional and several niches which could have been used as shelters to the guards of the Inca. Continuation to the ruins of **Puca Pucara** which would be a military construction having made part of the system of defense of Cuzco under the Inca empire. Descent towards **Qenqo**. This monument is often called an amphitheater because it has a semicircular construction. The purpose of this construction, which could have been used as an altar, a court or a tomb, is unknown.

The last ruin that we will visit is **the Inca fortress of Sacsayhuaman**. Originally built for defensive purposes between the XV and XVI centuries, the fortress is located at an altitude of 3,700 meters. It has the shape of a puma head, sacred animal in the Inca tradition. Return to the city center.

Lunch *

We will visit the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Assumption which is one of the main Catholic sanctuaries of the city. Founded in 1559 under the impulse of the viceroy Andrés Hurtado de Mendoza and the Spanish missionaries, it is the mother church of the archdiocese of Cuzco. We will continue our discovery of the historical center by the visit of the temple of Korikancha which is dedicated to the sun god. Erected on the famous temple of Qoricancha, the temple of the sun of the Incas is according to the Inca cosmology, situated in the center of the world.

DAY 4: CUSCO - PISAC / RUINS & MARKET - OLLANTAYTAMBO - AGUAS CALIENTES (6692FT) (Date to be determined)

Breakfast.

Meeting with our English-speaking tour guide.

8:00 AM: Discovery of the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Departure by private transport to Pisac, a village with many circular agricultural terraces of great fertility spread out on the mountainside. Perched on a hill, the archaeological complex of Pisac is certainly one of the most beautiful sites in the Sacred Valley. Former royal residence of the Inca Pachacutec, there are two different zones.

- -The residential area, composed of rustic buildings that were intended for farmers,
- -The ceremonial zone was intended for the nobility.

In the upper part of the complex is the **Intihuatana**, the sacred stone where the Inca priests worshipped the sun and which also served as an astronomical observatory. After visiting the archaeological site, we will head to the **Andean market of Pisac**, the largest handicraft market in the region.

Lunch.*

Transfer to **Ollantaytambo** where we will visit the archaeological site famous for its truncated pyramid platforms that the Spanish conquerors called the fortress. It is one of the most important sites before Machu Picchu!

DAY 5: AGUAS CALIENTES - MACHU PICCHU SANCTUARY - OLLANTAYTAMBO (9160FT) (Date to be determined)

Breakfast.

Meeting with our English-speaking tour guide.

Visit one of the most beautiful wonders of the world, Machu Picchu.

6:00 AM: **Transfer by bus** from Aguas Calientes to the foot of the archaeological site* which we will visit to learn more about this citadel, its Inca people and its culture.

*Optional: Ascent to Huayna Picchu or Machu Picchu mountain depending on availability. (Cost of 25 USD/Person)

The citadel is divided into two sectors:

The agricultural sector is surrounded by a succession of terraces of different types and sizes. It houses 5 magnificent granaries called Colcas.

The urban sector, meanwhile, contains the main architectural elements of an Inca city. The city is U-shaped and to the north, one can observe a large religious sector while to the south, one finds the residential city. In this area we can see the **Intiwatana**, considered by many to be the Inca's solar clock. Given its location, it is believed to have been a sacrificial altar.

2:30 PM: Departure on the Inca Rail train n^{ϱ} 44 to the village of Ollantaytambo.

4:04 PM: Arrival in Ollantaytambo and transfer on foot to the accommodation of our choise.

DAY 6: OLLANTAYTAMBO - MORAY CIRCUSES - MARAS SALTWORKS- CHINCHERO - CUSCO (11154FT) (Date to be determined)

8 AM: Discover the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Departure by private transport to the Moray Circles. This site consists of a main amphitheatre, with two smaller secondary amphitheatres nearby. They are made up of several terraces arranged in concentric circles. In fact, it was an Inca agricultural research center where cultivation experiments were carried out.

Located just a few minutes from Moray, we visit the **Maras salt flats**, salt terraces featuring thousands of salt pans fed by two springs with very high concentrations of sodium chloride.

Transfer to the village of **Chinchero**, an authentic indigenous village specializing in textiles and dyes.

DAY 7: CUSCO - COMBAPATA - MOUNTAIN OF 7 COLORS PALCOYO (16502FT) - PARAMIS SIALE COMMUNITY (12321FT) (PEOPLE QUECHUA) (Date to be determined)

Breakfast.

Meeting with our English-speaking tour guide.

5:00 AM: Route of the sun god Wiracocha & mountain of the 7 colors. Departure by private transport in direction of the south towards the lake Titicaca. At the height of the village of Combapata, we will continue by a path until the community of Palcoyo, located at 13451ft of altitude and at a few kilometers of it, at 15419ft of altitude, we will begin our hike that will lead us to several natural points of view where we will have privileged views of the cordillera of Palcoyo with its three colored mountains as well as a beautiful valley of rock formations.

This walk is an excellent option for people who do not want to make a long walk as is the case for the mountain of the 7 colors Vinicunca. Moreover, palcoyo is not very frequented!

Hiking level: Altitud level:

After a good moment to contemplate the landscapes, we will return on our steps in private transport towards Combapata.

Lunch.*

Halfway between Cusco and Puno, we will stop at **the Raya pass** which is the highest point of the road (14219ft). We will be able to appreciate beautiful landscapes, glaciers as well as numerous vicunas and llamas. Moreover, this place represents the point of union between two cultures: **Quechua and Aymara.**

Arrival to the village of Capachica and then we will continue on a track for a few kilometers to the community of Paramis Siale where we will settle down.

We will be welcomed by the natives and then we will discover the peninsula through a beautiful hike that will make us discover many medicinal plants and will lead us to the top, place from

DAY 8: TITICACA LAKE / PARAMIS - LLACHON - UROS TITINOS FLOATING ISLANDS - AMANTANI ISLAND (QUECHUA PEOPLE) (Date to be determined)

Breakfast.

Meeting with our local English-speaking guide.

6:00 AM: **Discover Lake Titicaca**. Early departure for a 2-hour hike to the small village of **Llachon**. Along the way, the views of the lake are exceptional, especially from the top of the peninsula. We arrive in **Llachon** and meet our boat.



We leave by private boat for **the floating Uros Titino islands.** These few floating islands have existed for hundreds of years. The Uros fish, hunt birds and live off lake plants, notably totora reeds, which they use for their boats, houses and in the very foundations of their islands. After the visit, we'll sail to the beautiful and serene Amantani Island.

Arrival at the island port, greeted by the locals and settling in the accommodation of our choise.

Lunch.*

Depending on our physical condition, we can hike to one of the island's two peaks (**Pachatata or Pachamama**), where we can enjoy extraordinary views and a marvellous sunset.

Offering to the Pachamama. In the evening, by the fire, we make an offering to Mother Earth Pachamama.

Ancient Peruvians developed close ties with nature, marked by respect, fear and veneration. Human beings and animals depended exclusively on what the earth produced and gave them; it was therefore necessary to express veneration for the Earth as the source of life. The religion of the Andean world is based on ancestral rites that link human beings and their habitat. For the Andean cosmogony, Inti, or Sun God, was one of the most important gods; the Apus embodied the spirits that populated the tutelary mountains, and Mother Earth (Pachamama) was the goddess of fertility. In the logic of Andean reciprocity, offerings, known as pagapus, are a way of thanking the spirits associated with the forces of nature, for their kindness or benefits.

DAY 9: LAKE TITICACA / AMANTANI ISLAND - TAQUILE ISLAND - PUNO (12555ft) (Date to be determined)

Breakfast.

Meeting with our English-speaking tour guide.

8:00 AM: **Lake Titicaca**. Departure by private boat to **Taquile Island**. Taquile island has preserved many pre-Inca remains as well as Inca ruins and terraces. We will follow a path for about 1 hour to the main village. On the way, our tour guide will explain about traditions and live on the island. The life of the inhabitants of Taquile is regulated according to the Inca moral code *ama sua, ama llulla, ama qhilla ("don't steal, don't lie, don't be lazy")*.

Once in the main village, we will have free time to explore the local handicraft market. The textile industry is the main activity on this island and the garments they manufacture relate to their daily chores. In 2005, Taquile and its Textile Art were honored by being proclaimed "Masterpieces of the Oral and Intangible Heritage of Humanity" by UNESCO.

DAY 10: PUNO - FUNERARY TOWERS OF SILLUSTANI - JULIACA - LIMA / INTERNATIONAL RETURN (Date to be determined)

Meeting with our local English-speaking guide.

INCLUDES

Private transportation Puno / Sillustani / Airport. **Return to Lima and international flight.** Departure by private transport for **Juliaca** airport and en-route visit to the **archaeological site of Sillustani**. This is a funerary site, consisting of tower-shaped tombs known as "Chullpas". These were built by the Colla people, Aymaras who were conquered by the Incas in the 15th century. They contain the remains of several individuals, certainly grouped in families (up to ten individuals) and accompanied by offerings.

After the visit, we continue our journey to **Juliaca Airport**. Arrival and check-in for a regular flight to **Lima**.
